### B-4000 V1.01.04

#### Fixed Bugs:

1. In pre-defined mode, if presses are over than 3 times, it will be ignored.
2. When the WAN port mode is PPPoE, the Email log function can't work properly.

When DUT tries

to send the log mail via our mail server(mail.handlink.com.tw) there has a error message

reply from our mail server shows " Authentication failed".

3. DUT will reboot after client logged-in system and surf the Internet. After the reboot, client can't access the remote HTTP server, but still can access the Management UI, Email, FTP application

### B-4000 V1.01.02

#### Fixed Bugs:

1. The default setting of WAN port mode should be DHCP client, but now the default setting of WAN port is Static IP.
2. When we uncheck the serial number in the printout setting section in the accounting page, the s/n field on the accounting list page will become "000000" when we create a new account.
3. When we check the pre-defined item in the printer button setting section in the accounting, and then create some accounts by exclusive printer. We found those accounts didn't match the Spec. When we push printer's button 2 times continually, the account should be base on the profile 2. However the account's usage time is become the (usage time of button 1)\*2.

4. The message "Note: The button 1 setting will apply on "exclusive printer" button setting"

should be removed in the new accounting page. Because the new accounting page didn't have this message.

5. (1). The configuration backup file didn't include the NTP setting.

(2). There are 10 items for billing settings in the billing section of configuration backup file. But there are only four buttons for DUT to setup the billing profile.
